

Notes regarding our 2014 Parish Financial Report

- We thank you, the people of Kildysart, for your generous support for our parish in 2014 during which you contributed in excess of €42,000;
- We thank our parish finance council and our parish secretary for preparing the 2014 financial returns;
- Your generosity allows us to insure and maintain parish property (Church, Community Centre, Parochial House), celebrate the sacraments and respond to the needs of our community;
- Your contributions also helped the work of the Church at diocesan, national and world level;
- Our parish, in common with many charitable organisations, is facing financial challenges. We incurred a deficit of €2,558 in 2014, in addition to capital expenditure of €4,939;
- Every effort is made to keep expenditure as low as possible;
- We need to increase our income so as to allow us to build up a reserve to meet our future needs particularly regarding the upkeep of our Church;
- We encourage you to use the parish collection envelopes. This allows our parish to avail of the tax refund scheme. If you attend Mass in another parish your Kildysart envelopes will be returned to Kildysart parish and will help our parish finances;
- The tax refund scheme allows us to increase our income without any additional cost to the people of the parish. All you need to do is to complete the form which you received earlier this year. If you do not have the form you may receive it from the parish office or any member of the parish finance council;
